Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds announced that Iowa high schools would be able to start summer baseball and softball practice June 1. Our first game is scheduled for June 15 at home versus Logan-Magnolia.

- Please remember that tobacco, alcohol and pets are prohibited on school property.
- No sunflower seeds are to be consumed during games.
- Restrooms will be available (limited to one person at a time).
- Admission: \$5 for adults, students and children free

#### GRADUATION

#### MS/HS IMMUNIZATIONS FOR 2020-2021

<u>7th Grade</u>
For the 2020-2021 school year, the incoming 7th graders are required to have two vaccines prior to the start of school next fall:

1 time dose

Meningococcal (A, C, W, Y) Vaccine received on or after age 10

12th Grade

For the 2020-2021 school year, the incoming 12th graders are required to have 2 doses of the meningococcal (A,C,W,Y) vaccine prior to the start of school next fall, or 1 dose if received when the student was 16 years of age or older.
