FAMILY WEEK

The Iowa High School Athletic Association and Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union have an upcoming "Family Week" appearing in Iowa's Unified Activity Federation calendar for the first time in 2020-21. This week will prohibit any coach and/or teacher contact with student-athletes and prohibits any IHSAA or IGHSAU event from occurring. This non-contact period will run from Sunday, July 25, 2021 through Sunday, August 1, 2021.

The IHSAA's 2021 state baseball tournament will be exempt from this year's non-contact period. Future state baseball tournaments will have updated schedules to allow for the off week before the start of the next athletic year. There can be no athletic activities within IHSAA and IGHSAU member schools during that week.

In summary: No intentional or scheduled contact between any student-athlete and coach from their school at any place, at any time, and for any purpose during the prohibited period.
