Science

Science will look a little different this year as it has been changed to a new program called "Amplify". Students will be using their chrome books on a daily basis. Following are the highlights of the courses:

7th Science: Harnessing Human Energy- Force & Motion, Magnetic Fields- Phase Change- Populations & Resources- Matter & Energy in Ecosystems - Earth, Moon, & Sun

8th Science: Geology on Mars- Weather Patterns- Ocean, Atmosphere & Climate-Light Waves- Natural Selection- Evolutionary History

Social Studies

Understanding the world around you and using deductive thinking strategies are lifelong skills that can be challenging work for many people, but are also a crucial part of your continued success in school and beyond. This class will provide you with the tools and skills you need to be a better student and a more informed global citizen.

In 7th grade Global Studies, we will learn about people, places, and environments in different regions of the world with an emphasis on Africa, Asia, and Oceania.

Students will review how to use maps and other geographic tools to acquire, process, and synthesize information. In each unit of study, we will examine a region's characteristics, history, and culture so as to better understand the world in which we live.

In 8th grade United States History, we will cover the time period from early North American Colonial Settlers through the Civil War and Reconstruction. We will also put an emphasis on how the eras of history we are studying connect to modern day current events.

We are trying something new for 8th grade. Papers will be graded individually within a unit. The expectation is that students keep those graded papers. At the end of the unit, those papers in addition to notes will then be handed in as a packet for a unit grade of a B in the category of daily practice. If students would like an A on the unit grade, they will be able to choose a project from the choice board to complete. Students will have one work day, that I will designate, toward the beginning of each unit to choose and work on this project. The rest of the work time for the project will be in study hall or at home. They will have the timeframe of the entire unit to complete this project.

Grading 7th and 8th grade

Grades will be divided into two categories, assessment and daily practice. Assessments will be worth 60% of the class grade and Daily Practice will be worth 40%. There will be some assigned projects that will be graded as assessments. Remember, I am here to help you through this school year. I believe that you will achieve amazing things. I am usually available before school, after school or 2nd hour if you need to make an appointment to receive help on any of your assignments.
