

SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

The principal may authorize programs or activities in the form of a school assembly when such events contribute to the achievement of education goals of the school district. School assemblies shall comply with the school calendar.

In authorizing a school assembly, the principal will consider the financial condition of the school district, the educational benefit of the activity, the inherent risks or dangers of the activity, and other factors deemed relevant by the principal or superintendent.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to inform the board of the approved school assemblies.
