



Some Key Tips To Know About The Recruiting Process:

- ❖ No two conversations with any coach will be identical.
- ❖ You're going to be both **NERVOUS** and **EXCITED**, so have a list of questions handy (on a piece of paper or in your phone) to ask them at any given time.
- ❖ Study about the school, the coach and their athletic program as much possible so that you're prepared.
- ❖ Don't waste time on questions that you know the answer to. This is where homework comes into play. If you know a significant amount of information about the school as opposed to the coach & the program, or vice versa.
- ❖ **Don't bring up scholarships** in your initial conversation and save all questions about scholarships until the **END OF THE PROCESS**.
- ❖ Never be afraid to ask coaches about themselves and what they value. When you get coaches talking about themselves, it leaves you a greater opportunity to leave a good impression. It's natural human nature to feel good when discussing what we value in life, so let them tell you and make sure that you're listening to what they say.
