Dear Parent/Guardian,

During the last years of high school, some students take several concurrent enrollment courses through IWCC. This often results in a student having classes at the beginning or end of the school day. Even though students can be in the building to work on their college courses, we realize that it is not an ideal situation to stay in the building without an actual course.

Therefore, students will have the opportunity to take early release and/or late start for up to two class hours per semester. Early release can be used only at the beginning or end of the school day, which means the student would arrive to school later and/or leave school early. This “early release” is considered a privilege so students may take advantage of the opportunity as long as the following expectations are met:

- The student and parent(s) have signed the early release contract.
- The student is making satisfactory progress in **all** classes and is on track to graduate.
- The student’s attendance is satisfactory.
- The student must sign out in the high school office and leave school property during release time.

Note: Early Release may be revoked by violating the conditions noted above.
