2026 Enchanted Garden Junior/Senior Prom

Check-in direction when you arrive at school for Prom.

ONLY ATTENDING THE PARADE OF STARS

- If you are only attending the parade of stars and not attending prom or post-prom, check in for the parade of stars at the bag check. Then proceed to the photo stations in the East Gym.

ATTENDING ALL PROM and POST PROM ACTIVITIES

- You will check in at bag check before proceeding to the East Gym. All prom attendees must have their bags checked.
 - Prom attendees can check **ONE BAG** per person attending post-prom.
1. Bags will be searched and turned in at check-in. You will not have access to your bag until returning from Prom.
 2. Name tags will be attached to your bag.
 3. Bags should contain a comfortable change of clothes, shoes, and all personal items you will need for post-prom.
 4. No food or drink allowed - They will be thrown away
 5. If you want to carry a small purse to prom, it needs to be checked at the bag check.
 6. After the bag check, proceed to the East Gym.
 7. Bags will be located in the athletic hallway when you arrive from prom.

- All prom attendees must have bags checked in by 4:30 PM

Photo Stations - East Gym - 3:00 PM- 5:00 PM

- Photo Stations will be located in the East Gym
- Formal pictures by Tracy Gillespie Photography will be available.

Parade of Stars - Auditorium - 5:00 PM – 6:30 PM

The Junior Class invites all prom attendees and families to the Parade of Stars and Coronation in the High School Auditorium.

- Students and guests will be introduced.
- The coronation of the Prom King and Prom Queen.

Class Pictures- Choir Room - 6:30 PM

- Class pictures will be taken in the choir room after the parade of stars

Travel to and from Palace Event Center - 6:45 PM and 10:30 PM

- Travel will be provided to and from the Palace Event Center via Treynor School buses. You will not be allowed to drive yourself.

Prom Dinner/Dance 7:00 PM – 10:30 PM

- The dinner and dance will be held at the Palace Event Center.
- Prom attendance is required to attend post-prom. Contact Mr. Nickerson in case of extenuating circumstances.
- Leaving prom will result in parents being contacted and not being allowed to attend post-prom.

Post Prom 10:45 PM-3:00 AM

- Activities such as Inflatables, Art Room, Photo Booth, Games, Animal Encounters, Hypnotist, and Casino Room will be provided. A variety of food and drinks will be available.
- Bags will be located in the athletic hallway. Changing will be done in the designated locker rooms.

Disclosures

- Junior class parents will be conducting and chaperoning the parade of stars and the post-prom event.
- You will not be allowed to exit the building or go to your car during post-prom. All doors will be monitored.
- Students currently in middle school or those age 20 and over are **NOT** permitted to attend Treynor Prom as guests.
- If a student wants to leave post-prom early. Parents will be contacted for approval before they can leave.
- In case of an emergency, parents will be notified.
- If an attendee is caught with illegal items or breaking any rules, law enforcement and/or parents will be contacted.
- Students are responsible for their items during and after Post Prom.
- A hypnotist will be performing at Post Prom. Students will have the choice to participate on stage.
- Animal Encounters will be available with a variety of animals to interact with.

The junior class prom committee nor Treynor School is not responsible for lost or stolen items or injuries of any kind.

All students and guests are required to turn in ALL completed forms by March 27th at 3:30 pm in the HS Office.
